<b>Large Appliances</b>	<b>MUST BE LESS THAN 10 YEARS OLD*</b> Refrigerators, freezers, stoves, washers, dryers, microwaves	Used dishwashers, garbage disposal (*lead drinking water act 2014), water heaters, non-working appliances
<b>Architectural Items</b>	Mantels, wrought iron railings, spindles, stained glass, beams	Fireplace inserts (free standing woodstoves-acceptable)
<b>Baby</b>	Toys, clothes, clean playmats	Cribs, car seats, walkers. highchairs, pack n plays, baths
<b>Bathroom</b>	Vanities, medicine cabinets sinks (hardware removed)	All Bathtubs, shower inserts/door, unframed mirrors, faucets (*lead drinking water act 2014)
<b>Building Materials</b>	Lumber (4ft or longer) plywood (2x4 or 4x8) baseboards, trim (4ft or longer)	Particle board, drywall scraps

<b>Carpet/Rugs</b>	New carpet only- rolled. Bathroom Rugs	Used carpet, Area Rugs
<b>Doors</b>	Interior (wood, metal, bi-fold, glass or painted) All Exterior	Shower Door, mirrored door, garage door
<b>Electrical</b>	New in packaging	Plate covers, light switches, stripped wiring
<b>Electronics</b>	DVD players, working stereo/speakers, video game consoles	TV's, computer monitors, printers, copier/fax, laptops, towers
<b>Exercise Equipment</b>	Inflated Balance Balls, small dumbbells	Stationary bikes, treadmills, weight bench
<b>Flooring</b>	Hardwood, vinyl, laminate	Used flooring
<b>Furniture</b>	Couches, chairs, dressers, bookshelves, end/coffee tables bed frames, hutches, Antiques (no stains, tears)	Particle board (ex. IKEA or furniture you build from box), executive/large desks entertainment centers, futons,
<b>Hardware</b>	Knobs, hinges, nails, screws, bolts, fasteners, locks	Mixed bags/containers
<b>Home Exterior</b>	New shingles, new insulation, gutters, shutters	Used siding
<b>Home Interior</b>	Cordless window coverings, framed mirrors,	Blinds, unframed mirrors, or glass
<b>Kitchen</b>	Small appliances, utensils, dining sets	Tupperware/plastic ware stained, old, no lids
<b>Landscaping/Lawn/Garden</b>	Fencing, bricks, planters, yard tools, grills	Rusted out grills, non-working tools
<b>Lighting</b>	Lamps with shade, chandelier, sconces, outdoor, ceiling fan-complete in box	Non-working lights, NO fluorescent bulbs/fixtures, parts & pieces, lighting with insulation
<b>Mattresses/Bedding</b>	Bedding, sheets, blankets, comforters, comforter sets, quilts, bed frames	mattresses, pillows, electrical blankets, air mattress, mattress pads. NO urine/pet/fluid staining
<b>Paint</b>	paint supplies	paint, spray paint, dried paint, dirty brushes/rollers
<b>Plumbing</b>	New PVC & metal (4ft longer)	faucets
<b>Tools</b>	All working power tools, hand tools	Unworking tools
<b>Windows</b>	Complete double pane with sashes and frames	Single pane, older than 10 years, aluminum frame windows
<b>Misc.</b>	Home décor in current styles, knickknack/figurines, camping gear	Hard Hats, Helmets, life jackets, pianos/organs,guns/ammunition, hazardous/toxic chemicals
